Executive Summary

Euronext is pleased to share the updated high-level implementation schedule for the Oslo Børs migration to Optiq®, including EUA and Go-live dates. Two high-level documents and two technical documents are now available. The remaining Oslo migration technical documentation is due next week.

Following the Info-Flash of [13 December 2019](#), Euronext is pleased to announce the updated high-level implementation schedule for the Oslo Børs migration to Optiq®, including External User Acceptance (EUA) dates and updated Go-live dates for both Cash and Derivatives Markets. Details regarding the Fixed Income market migration to Euronext systems will be communicated in due course.

There will be a 'light' release of the Euronext Cash Next EUA (p-EUA) platform, with a subset of Equity Norway instruments listed, as of **17 March 2020**. The market data for Equity Norway instruments will temporarily be routed to existing channels until the new channels are made available. See Migration Guidelines for more information.

The Derivatives Next EUA (p-EUA) full release will be available for customer testing as of **13 April 2020**.

The Cash Next EUA (p-EUA) full release, including the new Oslo-specific Market Data Gateway (MDG) channels, will be available for customer testing as of **18 May 2020**.

Saturn OBOE in Next EUA (p-EUA) will be updated for Oslo specific features in **June 2020**.

Dress Rehearsals for Cash are **10 and 31 October 2020**. Dress Rehearsals for Derivatives and Fixed Income are **14 and 21 November 2020**. Customer participation in at least one dress rehearsal for each Go-live is mandatory.

The Production Go-live date for Cash is **9 November 2020** and the Go-live for Derivatives and Fixed Income is set for **30 November 2020**. These dates are pending regulatory approval.

Customers are reminded that Euronext EUA environments on Optiq® for both Cash and Derivatives are already available for connectivity and testing. SLC Manager on Saturn is also available for testing.
