



## DATA SOLUTIONS

Further to previous [announcements](#), Euronext updates clients regarding the migration of its file-based data products currently accessible via [ftp.data.euronext.com](ftp:data.euronext.com) (also known as NDM) and email onto the new delivery platform – dubbed the Data Shop.

**Some technical issues have been identified during phases 1 and 2 of this migration. An updated technical release aiming at fixing those issues is planned for the coming weeks. Euronext decided to extend phases 1 and 2 of the migration. Furthermore, clients are informed that an updated planning for phase 3 will be provided before 31 March 2023.**

## ACTIONS REQUIRED

Phase 1

Clients who have not yet done so are required to test the connectivity to the new sftp server **before 31 March 2023**.

To perform this test clients should contact Euronext at [ndm.migration@euronext.com](mailto:ndm.migration@euronext.com) to obtain the username required to set up their sftp connection and download a dummy file.

## Phases 2

Clients subscribed to **Historical Data products** (except the RAW – aka PCAP – products) are required to adjust their processes/systems to start accessing the files/data products in scope of this phase on the Data Shop platform **before 31 March 2023**.

To ensure a smooth transition, Euronext will deliver the files on the Data Shop platform and the legacy server (<ftp.data.euronext.com>) in parallel until 31 March 2023.

The delivery of the files in scope of this phase on the legacy server (<ftp.data.euronext.com>) will stop on 31 March 2023.

Clients may find updated historical data – aka NextHistory - products client specifications [here](#) (see under “Historical data” section).

## Phases 3 and 4

Clients will be required to adjust their processes/systems to start accessing the files/data products on the Data Shop platform.

The files/data products will be provided in parallel on the Data Shop platform and the legacy NDM server (see table above). At the end of date of each phase, the delivery of the files/data products in scope of that phase on the legacy NDM server is planned to stop (e.g the delivery of the historical data files on the legacy NDM server is planned to stop on 31 March 2023).
