#### DEFINITIONS

- Production Euronext Markets on Optiq and surrounding systems hosted in the Data Centre in Basildon, United Kingdom.
- "New" Production Euronext Markets on Optiq and surrounding systems hosted in the <u>Data Centre in Bergamo, Italy.</u>
- Disaster Recovery (DR) A Euronext Disaster Recovery event occurs when Euronext switches client systems processing from the Euronext production environment to the Euronext DR environment. The DR environment provides redundant standby systems to be used upon the failure of the Euronext Production environment.
- "New" Disaster Recovery (DR) A Euronext Disaster Recovery event occurs when Euronext switches client systems processing from the future Euronext production environment to the future Euronext DR environment. The future DR environment remains hosted in the <u>Data Centre in Saint-Denis</u>, France and must provide redundant standby systems to be used upon the failure of the Euronext "New" Production environment.
- Dress Rehearsal The Dress Rehearsals will take place before the Go-Live weekend, allowing customers to test the target "New" Production Data Centre infrastructure and "New" Disaster Recovery.
- **Roll-back** Data and applications are reverted back to the situation as on Friday evening, before each Dress Rehearsal.
- **SP** Service Provider.
- **CMC** Client Managed Connectivity.

# **1. DRESS REHEARSAL**

The objective of the Dress Rehearsal is to simulate the Data Centre migration of Euronext's trading architecture and to validate that all services are fully operational.

The third Dress Rehearsal will allow clients to simulate the conditions of the migration weekend and connect their trading systems to the "New" Production environment (hosted in the Aruba Data Centre) and telnet to the Disaster Recovery environment. A failover to the Euronext Disaster Recovery site was simulated during the first and second Dress Rehearsals.

Euronext strongly recommends that clients participate in the third and final **Dress Rehearsal on 21 May 2022**. Note that the third Dress Rehearsal is the last opportunity for functional testing on the New Production environment. Euronext recommends all clients that have not yet participated in a Dress Rehearsal to test on the "New" Next EUA environment prior to participation in the third Dress Rehearsal.

Clients can use the <u>webform</u> to register for the Dress Rehearsal.

General notes:

- The Dress Rehearsal takes place on a Saturday to avoid impact on Production services. It supports functional testing on the "New" Production and "New" Disaster Recovery environments.
- Clients will be authorised to take part in the Dress Rehearsal weekend only if they have validated their connectivity set-up during the technical testing phase by completing and returning the "Test Form for Unicast & Multicast - New Production Environment - Aruba Data Centre".
- Clients are invited to participate actively in the Saturday test by sending orders / quotes to enrich the orderbooks.

At the end of the Dress Rehearsal, Clients must roll back all data and applications to the situation as it was on the previous Friday evening (at the end of the Trading session).

#### **1.3 SCOPE OF THE TEST**

The scope of the Dress Rehearsal is outlined below for each specific section.

#### 1.3.1 Markets

The scope of the Dress Rehearsal day is to perform administrative and functional testing for all Markets operated by Euronext and the Bourse de Luxembourg Market.

Markets in scope are:

- Euronext Markets All Euronext Cash & Derivatives Markets
- Other Market Bourse de Luxembourg

#### **1.3.2 Environments**

The following environments are in scope for the Dress Rehearsals, however the scope of each Dress Rehearsal can be adjusted.

**Note:** The Disaster Recovery environment will not be functionally available for clients testing during the Third Dress Rehearsal. Telnet to "New" Disaster Recovery environment remains available any time as of 4 April 2022 and also available during the third Dress Rehearsal.

# **1.3.4** Not in scope for the Dress Rehearsal

Clients should be advised that post-trade systems and front-to-back testing is not available on the Dress Rehearsal. Clients that wish to validate their front-to-back systems are invited to connect to the Next EUA environment to test all their posttrade applications.

# **1.4 TEST SCRIPT FOR DRESS REHEARSAL**

For a detailed description of all the tests to be performed by clients, please see the <u>Euronext Data Centre - Migration Guidelines</u>, section 4. Below is a summary of the most important tests to be performed during the Dress Rehearsal.

#### Test to be performed:

Log-on for OEG. All Trading members are advised to perform a successful log-on with at least 1 logical access per segment they trade, and this should be replicated for each Member Code / FIRM ID owned by the Trading Member. In addition, the client should perform the test from all the forecasted network sources (i.e. Colocation, CMC, Indirect colocation, Indirect CMC) and Service Providers that may be used in Production.

Note: The **Optiq OEG IP-Filtering** security will be put in place as it will be for Production Go-Live planned on 6 June 2022, meaning that only source IPs already registered for dedicated Firm IDs (Logical Access) will be allowed to receive Log-on acknowledgement.

- 1. For clients not impacted by infrastructure change, the source IPs set-up is replicated from Basildon to Bergamo.
- 2. For clients impacted by infrastructure change, the following process is applied:
  - a) For Direct clients, IPs are assigned and registered by Euronext.
  - b) For Indirect clients (clients behind Service Providers), firstly IPs are assigned by the SP according to the range assigned to the SP by Euronext. Secondly, IPs are registered by Euronext upon the SP's request.

Prior to the Dress Rehearsal, clients are strongly advised to test the Log-on on the Next EUA environment, as Optiq OEG IP-Filtering is already in place on this environment. In the case of any issues linked to Log-on, clients are advised to contact the Operational Client Services desk.

In addition, Euronext can provide the list of already registered source IPs to the client on request to <u>cas@euronext.com</u> (the request should include Firm ID).

- Functional OEG. Trading Members are advised to send orders.
- Functional MDG. Trading Members are strongly advised to validate the Market Data messages received. The Market Data message received could be both technical and functional (clients should be aware that functional messages will be disseminated when clients send orders to the market). This includes standing data, real-time feeds and snapshots.

Note: Clients without trading access can only validate the receipt of Market Data.

- Web Applications. Trading members are advised to validate the access to the applicable web applications (EFS, Saturn, Trade Confirmation System, EOD). The availability of each application per environment will be confirmed per Dress Rehearsal.
- Multi-User Cross-Connect Colocation Services. Colocated clients with a multi-user Cross-Connect to consume market data from a Service Provider or to get access to the Euronext Markets through their broker are strongly recommended to validate their Cross-Connect during the Dress Rehearsal to ensure readiness for Go-Live.

Note: If a given member is using different connectivity set-ups, it is strongly invited to test within all its possible connectivity combinations.

# **3. IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

Clients are advised to keep the below reminders in mind during and after the Dress Rehearsal.

### 3.1 TRADING DATE REFERENTIAL FILES

The trading date during the dress rehearsal **will reflect the date of the following Monday**. Since the instruments and orderbook will reflect the situation of the following Monday, all corporate events that took place the day before (on Friday evening) will be considered.

Please see below the complete list of the EFS files that will be present during the Dress Rehearsal planned for 21 May 2022.

Clients should be aware that date on the filename will reflect the date of Monday 23 May 2022, so for example the Block standing data file will be named: OptiqMDG\_PROD\_CashStandingDataFile\_Block\_20220523.xml.

This logic is true for all files that will be published on Saturday 21 May 2022.

### **3.2 FAILOVER TO THE DISASTER RECOVERY SITE**

The Disaster Recovery event consists of a failover from the "New" Production environment in Aruba, Bergamo to the "New" Disaster Recovery site in Saint-Denis, Paris. Data are disseminated when the Disaster Recovery site has been started completely. A failover to the Euronext Disaster Recovery site was simulated during the first and second Dress Rehearsals and is not in scope of the third Dress Rehearsal on 21 May 2022.

# 3.3 ROLL-BACK OF CLIENT APPLICATIONS

After the Dress Rehearsal test, clients must restore/roll back their internal Production systems to reflect the conditions of Friday evening (day before the Dress Rehearsal), including all corporate events.

It is important that clients do not synchronise their order book with data from the Dress Rehearsal test day.

Clients are responsible for purging all market data and order entry data sent and received during the Saturday Dress Rehearsal test.
